ARE YOU MAKING DISCIPLES FOR JESUS CHRIST?

All of us want our lives to count. As followers of Jesus we want to be like him in both his character and his missional priorities. But effectiveness in serving God is not always as easy as it seems. At The Campus Church, we want to help you find your sweet spot and be effective in living on mission, both in the church, and also where you live work and play. Do you sense you are at that place in your walk with God?

We have recently launched a training initiative called "On Mission". This equipping is cohort based, where you can journey toward greater effectiveness in making disciples with a few other like-minded people. The equipping will focus on three essential themes.

What is your calling?

What is God's call on my life and how can I reflect that in my spheres of influence?

How will you serve in the church?

How has God wired me for effective service and what is my contribution to the health of our church?



How will you impact your community?

How does God want to use me in reaching lost people and how can I become an effective witness for Him where I live, work and play?

Cohort based

Once a cohort group is identified we will meet together for 3 evenings, over 3 weeks, 3 times per year. Most modules will run from 7-9 pm on a weeknight. The modules will be approximately 3 months apart to allow for reading and assignments to be completed.

- How did Jesus make disciples?
- Understanding God's calling for my life within his broader mission
- · What you do best in the body of Christ.
- How I can make disciples.

- Being the good news developing strategies for maximum impact for God's kingdom.
